With its four ISO 7 clean rooms and an integrated microbiological laboratory, it offers stakeholders in the pharmaceutical and medical sectors increased flexibility and reactivity. Its infrastructure is set up to manufacture large volumes at high speed, with efficient automated processes ideally suited to cutting-edge healthcare requirements.





The **FaiveleyTech Ticino** site (formerly Socoplast) complements this site perfectly, and is located in Switzerland, specialising notably in **medical devices**.

Fitted with an ISO 8 clean room, it offers clients the possibility of creating prototypes, supporting product design and studies. Expertise in micro-injection, assembly, welding and finishing is particularly pertinent for the production of small and medium sized serial products.

Versability and gateways promote innovation and efficiency

Stripping back the partitions between sectors leads to unique opportunities. This is a fervent belief of FaiveleyTech. The many gateways created between Healthcare, Beauty and Industry bear testament to this. The healthcare brands are similar to those in the beauty sector, and monitor their innovations closely.
